

【Ski Safety Code】

We are doing our best to maintain a safe ski area.

You must observe the code listed below and the restrictions list to avoid accidents. For snowboards, please read the word 'skiing' as 'snowboarding'.

1. Be aware that there are elements of risk while a skiing.

So common sense and personal awareness can help to reduce risks.

- ① Be cautious of weather conditions such as snow, wind, and fog.
- ② Be cautious of such obstacles as cliffs and bumps.
- ③ Be cautious of snowy conditions such as icy areas and avalanches.
- ④ Be cautious of the natural environment including stones, tree branches, etc.
- ⑤ Be cautious of man-made objects such as lifts, buildings, and cars.
- ⑥ Be cautious of avoid collisions with fellow skiers.
- ⑦ Be cautious of your own areas.

2. Do not go out of the ski areas. keep off closed trails.

3. Parents should not leave their children alone.

4. We are not responsible for any injuries that are considered to be caused by negligence or from disregarding the warnings and restrictions.

If you do not agree with the above codes you shall not be permitted to ski at this location.

You may be forced to leave the ski area if when be see irresponsible behavior.

【Restrictions】

1. You must not bother or hurt others.

2. Always stay in control of your speed and consider all of the following: the roughness of terrain, the weather and snowy condition your ability and health and the crowdedness of the ski area order to avoid risks.

3. People ahead of you have the right of way; it is your responsibility to avoid them.

4. Whenever passing others, you must have enough space between them and yourself.

5. Whenever starting downhill, merging into a ski area, or crossing a ski area, look uphill to avoid others.

6. You must not sit down on the slopes it is narrow or in an area where you are not visible to those above you. If you fall, please try to get out of the way as quickly as possible.

7. Use the edge of the ski area when you climb, walk, or stop skiing.

8. You have to use bindings for skis and snowboards.

9. Observe all posted signs, warnings, and announcements, as well as well as indications from ski patrollers or staff.

10. When you see an accident, cooperate with rescue operations and report the accident by providing all your information whether you are one of the parties involved or a witness.

11. You are not permitted to re-sell your ticket.
